

# **2019 HRET Volunteer Application**

Equine-Assisted Activities and Therapy (EAAT) Riding Program "Empowering people through the spirit of the horse"

Holistic Riding Equestrian Therapy (HRET) program's goal is to provide safe, fun, skill appropriate mounted EAAT activities for veterans or those individuals navigating life with special needs. OUR BIGGEST NEED FOR VOLUNTEERS IS EVENINGS: MONDAY AND WEDESNDAYS AND MORNINGS: TUESDAYS AND WEDENSDAYS. THURSDAYS AM AND PM ARE ALSO NEEDED. We do NOT currently teach on weekends.

## **Volunteer Requirements (for helping with classes)**

- 14 years of age
- Complete a PATH training program provided by HRET
- Commit to a minimum 1 morning or evening shift per week & 2 sessions (8-12 weeks)
- Commit to a regular schedule
  - Example options: Monday and Wednesday evenings 4:30-7:15pm or Tuesday and Wednesday mornings 8:30-12
  - Consistency is essential to running a successful program. Riders start to trust and depend on their team and CANNOT RIDE WITHOUT YOU!!!
- Capable of physically meeting the qualifications for the horse leader or side walker position and walking for 45 minutes
- Have a willing, positive attitude and value teamwork
- Interested in becoming familiar with our horses and riding equipment
- Being comfortable around people with cognitive and/or physical disabilities
- Willingness to adhere to all policies, procedures, Kopping barn rules and HRET guidelines
- Purchase a t-shirt, long-sleeve, or jacket that has HRET logo to wear while volunteering

#### **Types of Volunteers for Classes**

Horse Leader (horse experience helpful but not required): responsible for controlling the equine during a session and/or preparing the equine for participation in EAAT. The horse leader must constantly listen to the instructor and must insure that the horse starts, stops, and turns when necessary, while simultaneously allowing the rider to be as independent as possible. When several horses are in the arena, the leader must make sure there is an adequate safe distance between horses. Leaders must be capable of focusing exclusively on their horse and reading the signs to predict behavior changes prior to them occurring.

**Side walker:** responsible for the rider during the lesson session. If two side walkers are required, one will be responsible for the rider upon arrival for lessons and see to it that the rider is safely back with parents/guardians after the lesson. Side walkers may assist with rider mount/dismount and are positioned to assist rider with balance or directions when needed. Side walkers may also need to provide the rider with physical support by using a thigh or ankle support and stay in communication with the horse leader. Side walkers take turns giving the rider instructions and will decide who will be the pitcher and catcher in the unlikely event of the need for an emergency dismount.
